

NAVIGATIONAL SCATTER - FRIDAY 02 OCTOBER 2020

1. Camel Vale Motor Club Limited will organise a Navigational Scatter event on **FRIDAY 2 October 2020**. The event will be open to members of the organising club. This will be a **1** round of the 2020 Camel Vale Navigational Scatter Championship and will count towards the 2020 Camel Vale Car Trophy, Under 21's Trophy
2. The meeting is held under the General Regulations of the Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations.
3. The Start and Finish of the event will be at Rally Prep, St Columb Industrial Estate, St Columb Major, TR9 6SF Map Ref 200 / 908 628 You should expect to cover approx 60 miles. **Start times:** Novices will receive the route at 7:10pm, Scouts at 7:20pm and Experts at 7:30pm. Signing on will be from 6:30pm.
4. Motorsport UK Permit No - 119058
5. Awards will be presented at the Annual Dinner Dance as follows:
Driver of winning car - trophy plus replica, to be held for 11 months
Nominated Navigator of winning car - trophy plus replica, as above
1st in Class - subject to three starters in class
2nd - subject to five starters in class
3rd - subject to nine starters in class
6. Only the driver and nominated navigator are eligible for awards. Additional passengers are not permitted

The entry fee is £25.00 per car but with an **early payment reduction to £20** if the entry is received by the Secretary prior to 5:30pm on Tuesday **25 SEPTEMBER 2020** on an **official CVMC Entry Form and accompanied by the appropriate fee**. The maximum number of entries for the event is 25, the minimum is 6. Please note that the event may not run if sufficient entries are not received by the pre-closing date of Tuesday 25 September 2020 Exceptionally later entries at the full £25 fee will be accepted until 1 hour prior to the event in accordance with D.20.1.1
9. Detailed Provisional Results, in writing, will be made available in accordance with D26.1.2
10. **All drivers and navigators over the age of 16, must present a 2020 CVMC membership card**. Any passenger under the age of 18 must bring a signed parental consent form. All cars should look as standard as possible and carry a maximum of only two additional driving lights, no advertising on the vehicle, no excessive noise and no multi-coloured vehicles. All cars must be taxed, insured and where applicable have a current MOT. Torches, pencils, rubber and a Romer together with **OS Landranger 200**
