THE 2025 TREMAYLE TESTING TRIAL

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. Announcement

Camel Vale Motor Club Limited will organise a testing trial open to both adults and youths on Sunday 28 September 2025 at Tremayle Farm, Nanstallon, Bodmin PL30 5JY.

2. Jurisdiction

The meeting will be held under the National Sporting Code and the Standing Trials Regulations of the Auto-Cycle Union (ACU) and these Supplementary Regulations.

3. Permit

ACU Permit No: 206066

4. Eligibility

The event is open to fully elected members of the organising club, as well as members of Camel Vale Motor Cycle Club, Holsworthy Motor Club, Launceston & North Cornwall Motor Club, the MCC, North Devon Motor Club and Pendennis Motor Cycle Club.

Competitors and passengers are required to produce their club membership card together with their ACU Competition Licence at signing on. One Event Trials Licences will be available to purchase at signing on if required. Any competitor under the age of 18 will require parental consent.

Competitors of at least 4 years of age are permitted to enter. Youth riders or passengers aged 15 or under must have a parent or legal guardian present at the event.

5. Event Programme

The programme of the meeting will be:

Signing on	09:30 hrs
Scrutineering	09:30 hrs
Drivers briefing	10:30 hrs
Competition commences shortly thereafter	

Any competitor not signed on by 10:15 hrs may be disqualified.

6. Classes

The event classes are:

CLASS A.	Motorcycle outfits
CLASS B.	Motorcycle – adult 16+
CLASS C.	Motorcycle – youths aged 4 – 6
CLASS D.	Motorcycle – youths aged 6 – 12
CLASS E.	Motorcycle – youths aged 12+

All vehicles must comply with ACU Technical Regulations for trials.

Motorcycle requirements for youth competitors:

- Age 4 to 6 – electric bikes only, max 2bhp at the rear wheel

- Age 6 to 12 – combustion engine max capacity 80cc or electric bike max 7bhp at the rear wheel
- Age 12 to 16 – combustion engine max capacity 125cc (mono); 250cc (twinshock) or electric bike max 10bhp at the rear wheel

Competitors in Class C must be accompanied by a minder aged over 18 on all sections.

As the event takes place wholly on private property, vehicles need not be taxed or registered.

All vehicles must have effective silencing. Any vehicle considered by the scrutineer to be too noisy will not be allowed to start.

7. Event Description

The event will consist of a number of short time tests over a series of marked out sections on grass.

Timing will be by marshal's handheld stopwatch. Timing will commence on verbal instruction of the marshal at the start of the test. Timing will conclude when the competing vehicle is stopped astride the finish line.

Results will be calculated using the total time taken to complete all the tests. The best performance will be the competitor with the lowest score.

Penalties will be imposed as follows:

- Incorrect route taken/wrong test – maximum score (fastest time in class plus 20 seconds)
- Hitting section marker or failing to stop astride – 5 seconds per incident
- Footing – 5 seconds per footing (except for competitors in Classes C, D and E)

Details of the sections and any final instructions will be issued at signing on.

Please note: Practising with a vehicle is not permitted, however competitors are able to walk the sections prior to competing should they wish.

8. Identification

Vehicles will be identified by numbers supplied by the organisers.

9. Awards

Awards will be presented as follows:

Overall winner	A trophy
Class win in each Class	subject to 3 starters
2nd in each Class	subject to 5 starters
3rd in each Class	subject to 9 starters

No competitor may win more than one award.

Awards will be presented at the Camel Vale Motor Club awards evening in early 2026.

10. Entries

The maximum entry for the meeting is 30 and the minimum is 6. The minimum for each class is 3. Should the minimum number of entries not be reached 48hrs prior to the event, the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting or amalgamate the classes as necessary.

Vehicles may be double driven.

Entries open on publication of these SRs and will close finally on Friday 26 September 2025. All entries are accepted at the organiser's discretion.

The entry fees are: Adult: £25
 Under 16: £15

All entries must be made using the online entry form available on the club website www.camelvalemotorclub.co.uk.

Entry fees will be refunded if notice of withdrawal is given in writing to the event secretary 48hrs prior to the event. All refunds will be subject to an administration fee of £5.
